The Servant of God

Isaiah 42:1-12

- I. Do you know how hard it is not to break a bruised reed or to quench a smoldering wick?

- II. My Servant, whom I uphold (Is 42:1)
 - A. My Chosen, in whom my soul delights (Mk 1:11)

 - B. Justice is the job of this chosen servant of God!

- III. The Biblical idea of justice includes all of life returning to God

- IV. Character of Biblical Justice
 - A. Humility (Isa 42:2, Phil 2:8)

 - B. Gentleness (Isa 42:3, Jn 8)

 - C. Faithful (Isa 42:4)

V. Justice can only come from one who is:

A. Powerful (Isa 42:5)

B. Righteous (Isa 42:6)

C. A Light (Isa 42:6, John 1:5)

VI. Justice is for the oppressor and the oppressed (Isa 42:7)

VII. Jesus is the ultimate fulfillment of this passage (Mt 12:15-20)

VIII. Worship is the right response to justice coming in Christ
(Isa 42:10-12)
