God is Moving Mountains

The Kuki-Mizo-Chin people are one ethnic group, called by different names depending on whether they are in Bangladesh, India, or Burma/Myanmar. They are a Christian people. In Bangladesh's eastern Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) the Kuki-Chin demand an autonomous state where their people, lands and culture can be protected from colonization by Bengali Muslims, and from domination by the mostly Buddhist ethnic Chakmas (the largest ethnic minority group in the CHT). For this they suffer persecution and military violence. In October 2022, the Bangladeshi government launched a military operation against 'separatists and terrorists' in the CHT. In April, hundreds of Kuki-Chin Christians spent Easter displaced and grieving after 'state sponsored' militants attacked Khamtangpara village, Bandarban District, killing one man and capturing dozens, seven of whom they later tortured and executed. Please pray God will intervene to sustain all Kuki-Chin Christians who are impoverished, cut off from aid, displaced and imperiled on account of ethnic-religious discrimination, persecution and military violence.

Commands to Husbands and Wives

Colossians 3:18-19

- Marriages are hard work.
- II. But they are beautiful too.
- III. Household codes flow out of Col 2:6, 3:5, 8, 10, 12-14, 17
- IV. Two commands for husbands (Col 3:19)
 - A. Command 1: Love your wives
 - 1. Continuously, intentionally, actively love them.
 - a. In Scripture we are also commanded to love the brotherhood (1Pt 2:17)
 - b. Commanded to love one another (1Pt 1:22)
 - c. In Scripture, Jesus commands us to love our enemies 3x (Mt 5:44, Lk 6:27, 6:35)
 - d. And 3x a husband is commanded to love his wife (Eph 5:25, 5:33, Col 3:19)
 - 2. What does it mean to love someone?
 - a. Do you recall Jacob's love for Rachel? (Gen 29:18)
 - b. Love doesn't harm (Rom 13:10)
 - c. Love is (1 Cor 13:4-8)
 - d. Because love is seeking her best it will be expressed in devotion to her (Mt 6:24)
 - e. Loving also means speaking the truth to her. (Mk 10:21)

- 3. Husbands, do you understand the gravity of the command you are being given? (Eph 5:25-27)
- 4. Love doesn't demand anything
- 5. Only in walking with Christ can this happen
- B. Command 2: Do not be harsh with them
- V. One command to the wives (Col 3:18)
 - A. "Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord." (Col. 3:18)
 - B. Submit (Eph 5:24, Titus 2:5, 1Pet 3:1)
 - 1. Given this, the idea of submission includes
 - a. Voluntary obedience (Lk 2:51)
 - b. Recognition of God-given position of authority (Rom 13:1)
 - c. Honor and reverence (1Cor 16:16)
 - 2. Practical considerations
 - C. As is fitting to the Lord (Col 3:18, Eph 5:4, Philemon 8)
