INDONESIA: CHRISTIAN THEOLOGIAN AND APOLOGIST ARRESTED

...seven months missing.

A Coptic Orthodox Christian, Gratia Pello (40), taught theology at Nusantara Bible School in Malang, East Java. With a wealth of knowledge on Christian theology, eastern Christianity, Arabic language, Islam and the Arab world, he also ran an apologetics YouTube channel where he critiqued Islam, answered questions, facilitated debates, defended Christianity, promoted the Bible and shared the Good News of Jesus Christ. On Tuesday 6 December 2022 Pello was arrested and taken to East Java Regional Police Headquarters where he was charged with blasphemy and imprisoned. Nothing has been seen or heard of Gratia Pello since his arrest. More Prayer Requests:

- Pray for the Pastors who are being equipped to continue their outreach ministry to bring hope to the people of Indonesia.
- Pray that God would comfort those rejected by their own families for His sake.
- Pray for ICR partners to continue being presented with opportunities to teach families about Christ.

I. God's people are called to praise him

- A. How?
 - 1. By being thankful (Ps 9:1)

2. By rehearsing God's great deeds to one another (Ps 9:1)

3. By rejoicing and making music to the Lord (Ps 9:2)

B. Why?

- 1. He is the Most High (Ps 9:2)
- 2. He is just (Ps 9:4, 7-8; Jer 11:20)
- 3. His enemies are utterly defeated (Ps 9:5-6, 15-20; Col 2:15)
- 4. He is enthroned (Ps 9:7-8, Rom 12:19)
- 5. He is a protector (Ps 9:9-10)
- 6. He is faithful (Ps 9:10)
- C. David returns where he began "Worship God" (Ps 9:11)

- II. Applications
 - A. When we are in need, we should turn to the God we praise
 - 1. Call on God in prayer (Ps 9:13)
 - 2. Pray so that we can add our stories to the community's (Ps 9:14)
 - 3. Jesus could have prayed this
 - B. Consider if there is any wickedness or idolatry in your life (Ps 9:15-18)
 - 1. God judges the wicked
 - 2. Wickedness is forgetting God in daily life
 - C. Be encouraged, God's judgment will come. (Ps 9:19-20)
