- II. What does the bible say?
 - A. Hell was created to punish Satan and his angels for rebellion and his accusations against God's people (Mt 25:41, Rev 20:10, ZEch 3:1, Job 1 -2, Eph 4:27, 6:11)
 - B. How is this punishment described?
 - 1. Lake of fire and sulfur (Rev 20:10)
 - 2. Unending torment
 - 3. Eternal fire never goes out
 - 4. Weeping and gnashing of teeth (Mt 13:42, Acts 7:54, Ps 37:12)
