God is Moving Mountains

Vietnam's Intent to Control Religion

The Vietnamese communist party on Dec. 29, 2023 made public Decree 95, and on that date also announced that the laws in the decree would be going into effect on March 30, 2024. This decree was passed before any public consultation was made on it and is trying to be framed as a series of laws that support and encourage religious freedom. Decree 95 is replacing Decree 162 and the punishment decree that was already in place, but it adds 8 more articles, and 3 extra forms religious groups must fill out to the ones already in existence. Decree 95 adds two specific additions that should be taken note of. The first addition includes 10 measures on shutting down and "rehabilitating" activities of religious groups and education institutions to meet government regulations. The second addition is in articles 25-27 and include new requirements for complete and prompt fundraising and financial reporting of foreign aid and support. Please pray for the churches in Vietnam as they face figuring out how to navigate these new regulations.

Additional Prayer Requests

- 1. Pray the pastors in Vietnam will find creative ways to be able to continue working in ministry with the new government regulations.
- 2. Pray for the Vietnamese government to be blinded to the activities of the church in the country.
- 3. Pray the believers in Vietnam will find ways to share the Gospel with government officials so that the government is transformed from the inside out.
