God is Moving Mountains

For many years now, in Azerbaijan, churches have been denied the ability to register legally. Secret police attend and sometimes raid church meetings, which the government classifies as illegal. Bibles are difficult to obtain. Churches can purchase them, but they cannot be printed legally. In 2015, the government published a list of banned religious books that included the Old Testament. Those caught with banned religious literature are fined. The government is tightening restrictions and often asks church leaders to submit lists of members' names. Some pastors and leaders feel this is an attempt to gather information for later use against church members or pastors. Many Christians faithfully share Christ with neighbors and family members despite legal pressure and possible fines.

How to Pray:

- 1. Praise God that many Azeri Christians are proclaiming Christ despite the risk of legal problems and heavy fines.
 - 2. Pray that churches will withstand government efforts to monitor, control or close them.
- 3. Pray that secret police sent to monitor and raid worship services will instead come to faith in Christ.
