God is Moving Mountains

Kenya is predominantly Christian, but several tribal groups in the north remain largely unreached, and much of the coastal region is predominantly Muslim. Additionally, in the region known as Greater Somalia in northeastern Kenya, 90 percent of the population is ethnically Somali and fervently Muslim.

Christians in these areas cannot openly discuss their faith without risk of losing their family, livelihood and standing in their community. There is a significant threat of violence against Christian converts. In northeastern Kenya, the al-Shabab Islamic terrorist group attacks Christians, bombing churches and killing believers. In Muslim-majority coastal and northeastern areas, Christians are persecuted by local governments and rejected by their families and communities.

Church activity in these regions is severely limited by the local communities. The Kenyan constitution grants every citizen freedom of religion, but local governments in resistant areas are led by Muslim officials who do little to protect the rights of believers.

How to Pray:

1. Pray for believers to keep their focus on God and his truth, trusting in him fully despite their circumstances.
2. Praise God for the Christians who are standing strong and living in a way that points others to Christ.
3. Pray for God to reveal himself to those who stand against him, that their lives may be transformed through his mercy and grace.
